

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the county legislative body of <u>Sullivan</u> County, Tennessee, meeting in <u>Regular</u> session on this <u>17th</u> day of <u>April</u>, 19<u>B9</u>, that:

SECTION 1. The amounts set out in the fiscal  $19\underline{88} - \underline{89}$ Appropriations Resolution are continued and the various departments, offices and agencies are authorized to expend funds at the same level as the previous fiscal year.  $\$4.04 / \underline{City}$ 

SECTION 2. The property tax rate of  $\frac{4.56}{2}$  per each \$100 of taxable property for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1988, will remain in effect until a new property tax rate is adopted.

SECTION 3. The County Executive is authorized to borrow money on Tax Anticipation Notes not to exceed sixty percent (60%) of the appropriations of each individual fund, provided the notes are first approved by the State Director of Local Finance. The proceeds of such notes to be used to pay the authorized expenses of the county until the taxes and other revenues for fiscal year 19.89 - 90 have been collected. The notes evidencing the loans authorized under this Resolution shall be issued under the authority of T.C.A. § 9-21-101 et seq. All notes will mature and be paid in full, without renewal, on or before June 30, 19<u>90</u>.

SECTION 4. No local funds can be expended or obligated that exceed the previous year's budget appropriation until a new budget is adopted. Expenditures mandated by the State or rules and regulations adopted by the State are incorporated into this continuing budget.

SECTION 5. This Resolution will take effect from and after its passage and its provisions will be in force from July 1, 19 and until the budget and tax rate for fiscal year  $19_{.89} \sim .90$  is finally adopted and approved. The County Clerk shall include this Resolution in the minutes of the <u>Sullivan</u> County legislative body and send a copy to each county department head.


