





WHEREAS, The Crisis Center, CASA, Social Services, Abuse Alternatives, YWCA, American Red Cross, The Salvation Army, Bristol Youth Services, Bristol Family Resource Center, Bristol Life Saving Crew, Bristol Faith in Action, People Inc. of Southwest Virginia, CASA for Kids, Inc. of Kingsport serving Sullivan and Hawkins Counties, and Frontier Health of Gray, TN, are all human service agencies which service our region in supporting and requesting this proclamation. Additional agencies are in the process of supporting this action by written affirmation.

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 5, Chapter 5, Part 1, relative to county employees.



### **RESOLUTION** to authorize the Sullivan County Sheriff's Department to add one parttime employee (30 hours per week) for the Sullivan County Animal Control/Shelter.

WHEREAS, the Sullivan County Animal Control/Shelter has a staff of only four (4) officers to cover all of rural Sullivan County (the fifth largest county in Tennessee) as well as running the Animal Shelter; and

WHEREAS, in 2007 the Animal Control officers responded to 3,851 calls, set 81 dog traps and 330 cat traps. The officers also had 14 cases in Bristol courts and 11 cases in Kingsport courts. The Shelter also had a total of 4,257 visitors who had to be assisted; and

WHEREAS, in 2007 there was a total of 1,071 dogs euthanized as well as 1,487 cats - not counting the ones that expired while at the Shelter. There were 356 dogs adopted as well as 110 cats adopted for the same time period; and

WHEREAS, there are eleven (11) hours of scheduled overtime each weekend (Saturday – 7 hours and Sunday – 4 hours). The scheduled overtime results in a cost of \$11,360.00 per year. A part-time employee (30 hours per week) at a pay rate of \$10.50 per hour would cost \$16,380.00 per year (without benefits). This would be an increase in payroll of a little over \$5,000.00 per year; and

WHEREAS, the current officers are on call at all hours and could produce a liability to the county due to fatigue and could cause an unsafe incident to occur.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners of Sullivan County, Tennessee, assembled in Regular Session hereby approves the funds to hire a part-time employee (30 hours per week) for the Sullivan County Animal Control/Shelter.
