WHEREAS, by reason of a federal lawsuit entitled, Northwest Airlines, Inc. et al. Vs. Tennessee State Board of Equalization, Civil Action No. 3-91-0719, United States District Court for the Middle Division of Tennessee, Nashville Division, the Final Decree in said lawsuit required the State Board of Equalization to issue guidelines for the audit of locally assessed tangible personal property to verify accuracy in taxpayer listings of such property with the county assessors of property; and,

WHEREAS, the State Board of Equalization has now adopted such guidelines to be followed by county assessors of property in their implementation of a Tangible Personal Audit Plan; and,

WHEREAS, Sullivan County is presently in compliance with said state guidelines; and,

Tax Management Associates is pleased to submit the following analysis representing an estimate of the number of accounts by classes and cost for assisting your office in the implementation of a comprehensive Business Personal Property Audit Program.

Your program at the present time represents a state approved "Sample Audit Program Plan" authorized by state guidelines which TMA has assisted your office in implementation. It is our understanding that presently there is interest in moving to a "Full Audit Program Plan" as provided by the State Guidelines which will substantially increase the number of audits to be performed annually. It is also our understanding that it is your desire to implement such plan over a three year period.

State Guidelines require that a full audit program include a comprehensive field audit of all accounts reflecting appraised values of \$50,000 and greater. According to information provided by your office, the total number of accounts in this category is approximately 1,023. The following analysis reflects a breakdown of these accounts by value ranges and the cost to Sullivan County for the contracting of TMA audit services.

TMA's cost for service includes the scheduling of the audits, the audit performance, on-site review, preparation of audit correspondence, reports and assessments, defending the audit findings throughout the appeals process and all travel related expenses associated therewith. TMA will travel to the corporate headquarters of the taxpayer, or at such place where the taxpayers books and records are located, to perform the audit as required by State Guidelines. The selection of audits will be the responsibility of the county and all final decisions regarding the disposition of audit findings will be made by the county assessor or persons authorized by the county assessor.

As you are aware, TMA has contracted with 76 of the 78 Tennessee counties presently implementing full Business Personal Property audit programs. For your information and review, please find enclosed an analysis of data reflecting these counties results in the discovery of additional value found by TMA to be escaping ad valorem taxation and the revenue benefits derived therefrom. An additional benefit to these counties is future revenue benefits resulting from an increase in the tangible personal property tax base.

Please note that Washington County, an adjoining county to Sullivan, will incur a total cost of approximately \$598,000 for audit services upon the completion of their full program. During the first year of their program assisted by TMA, approximately \$600,000 in new revenue has already been assessed. Other counties comparable to Sullivan including Rutherford, Williamson and Montgomery have also experienced revenue benefits substantially in excess of their cost of audit services.

It has been suggested that the first year funding by Sullivan County for contracted services for assistance in the implementation of a full audit program be from the year 2000-2001 budget. Tax Management Associates agrees to begin providing its services immediately upon the approval of the county and to delay any payment for cost of its services until July 1, 2000.

TMA has enjoyed its relationship with Sullivan County and appreciated the opportunity to assist in the enhancement of your audit program. We commit to you the professional and quality of services you expect and we are available to move forward as you deem appropriate.


