THAT WHEREAS the Sullivan County Emergency Medical Service (EMS) has relocated the Blountville area paramedic unit from the Iri-City Airport area to a temporary location at the Sullivan County Jail Annex in order to reduce response times to emergency calls and be located in an area where statistics have shown that well over 60% of all EMS calls run by the Blountville unit occur in this area and have further proven that response times to these areas have been drastically reduced, thus creating more efficient patient care to the sick and injured living in the Blountville area of Sullivan County.

AND THAT the present temporary location of the EMS unit at Sullivan County Jail Annex has the immediate great potential of being utilized by the Sullivan County Sheriff's Department for the housing of prisoners due to overcrowding at the present jail facility and that occupying such a dwelling with an EMS unit and prisoners would not be suitable for EMS employees living and working conditions and create problems with the security of housing prisoners at the jail site.

AND FURTHER THAT efforts to establish other temporary locations will continue to interrupt EMS operations and be of great expense in developing temporary sites for EMS operations in the future and that said sites are presently limited in the Blountville area.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Sullivan County Commission give approval for the construction of a permanent EMS ambulance station for the Blountville area and that said funding will be made from the General Fund Surplus, not to exceed the grand total amount of fifty-five thousand dollars (\$55,000.) and that said site of construction be <sup>recommended</sup> selected by the appropriate County Court Committee. 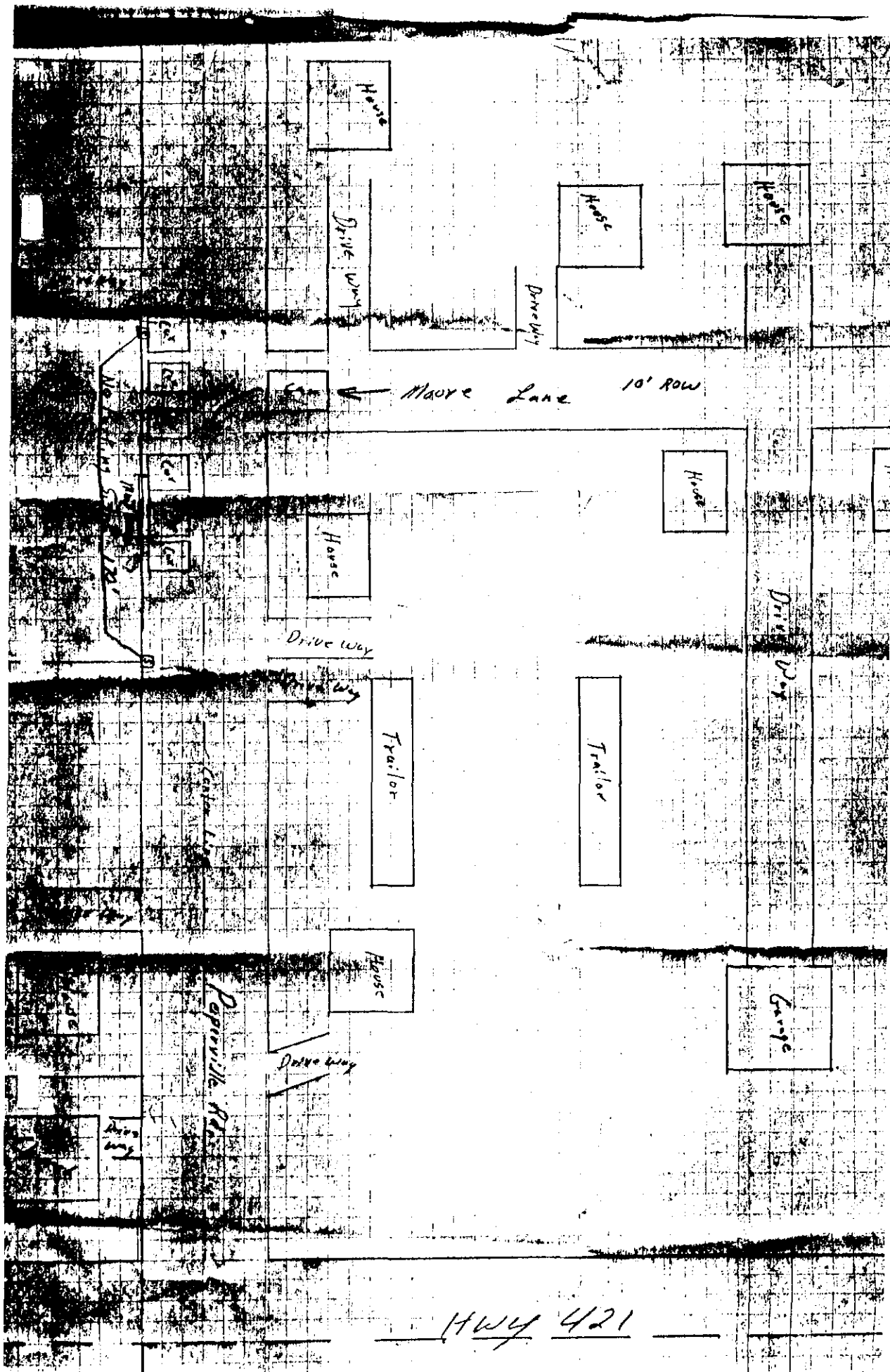
Mr. Marvell.

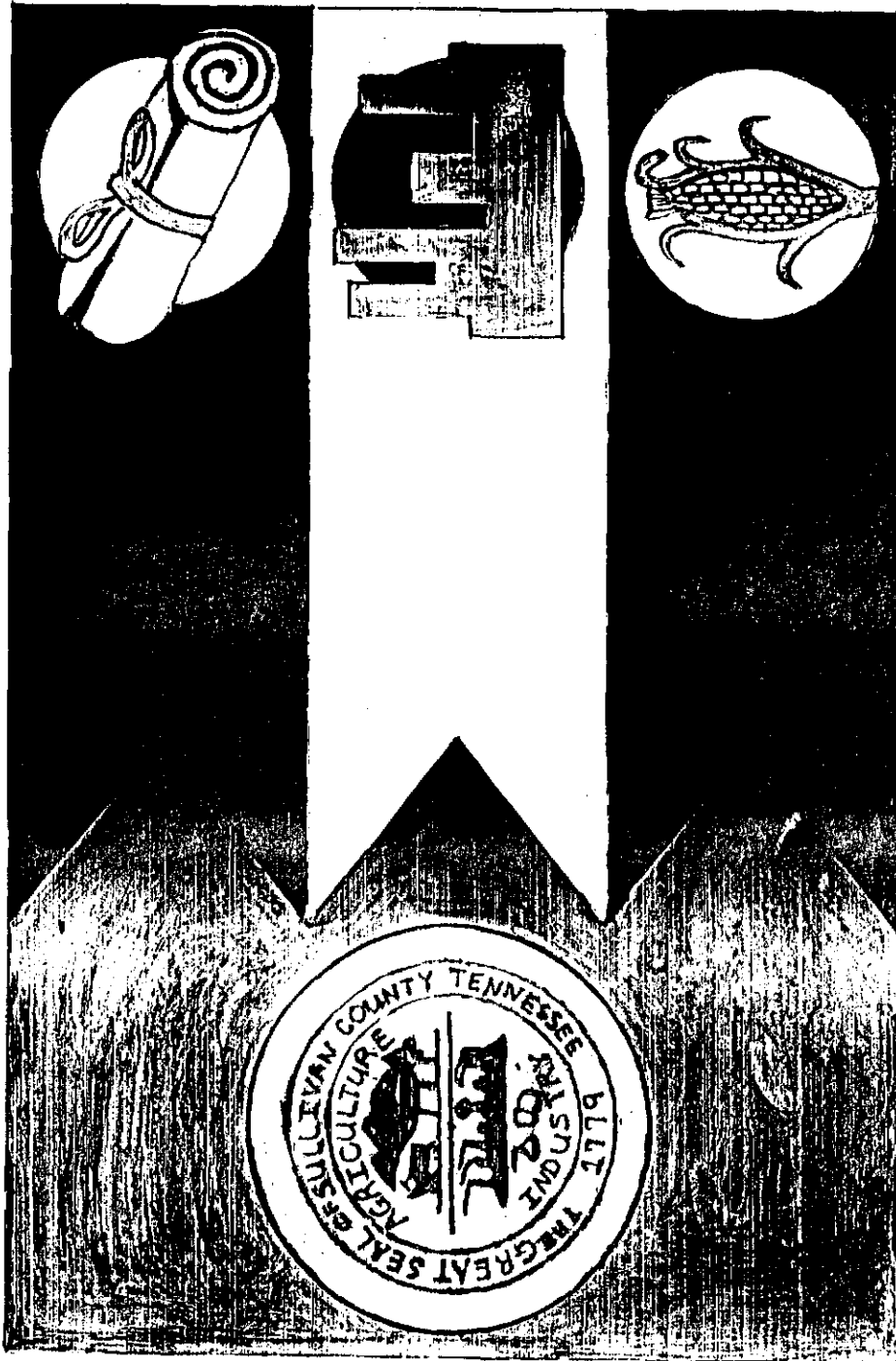
