Summary - Mountain View Road Property Description and Sale

 ~ 1

T-H-E Partnership Development Corporation (Tittle Construction Company) owns a 5.3 acre site at 722 Mountain View Drive in the Tri-County Industrial Park. T-H-E is proposing to construct a 10,000 sq. ft. building on the site for a client. The client is a small plastics' manufacturer and will employ 20 people at this location.

The client requires additional acreage for outside storage of their product. An 11.07-acre site adjacent to the T-H-E property is available. The site is irregular in shape and its entire length is transversed by Booher Creek with its floodplain covering about 60% of the site. Further, a steep slope is found at the back of the property. A sanitary sewer line and easement is located on the site and literally cuts across the middle of the property as it crosses Mountain View Drive. A TVA power line easement crosses the western portion of the site. All total, less than three acress of the site, will be usable for outside storage. Even this usable acreage will require excavation and sits six-to-eight feet below Mountain View Drive. To avoid holding non usable land, the park owners have offered to sell the entire site to T-H-E for the price of \$18,000.

CONTRACT BETWEEN CERTAIN MUNICIPALITIES AND THE PROPERTY OWNERS OF THE TRI-CITIES REGIONAL AIRPORT REGARDING THE MUNICIPALITIES' RIGHTS OF ANNEXATION

THIS AGREEMENT is entered into as of the dates of execution as shown below between the City of Johnson City, Tennessee; the City of Bristol, Tennessee; the City of Kingsport, Tennessee; and the Town of Bluff City, Tennessee (hereinafter called "Municipalities"); and the Tri-Cities Airport Commission doing business as an unincorporated joint venture consisting of Sullivan County, Tennessee; Washington County, Tennessee; the City of Bristol, Tennessee; the City of Bristol, Virginia; the City of Kingsport, Tennessee; and the City of Johnson City, Tennessee (hereinafter called "Property Owners").

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the Property Owners constitute an unincorporated joint venture and hold title to all property comprising the Tri-Cities Regional Airport and operate under the name of the Tri-Cities Airport Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Municipalities have the authority and power to annex property pursuant to the laws of the State of Tennessee; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to T.C.A. §6-58-104(a)(8), municipalities and property owners are authorized to enter into written contracts relative to the exercise of a municipality's rights of annexation; and

WHEREAS, the Municipalities and Property Owners desire to enter a written contract prohibiting the Municipalities from annexing any real estate owned by the Property Owners doing business as an unincorporated joint venture under the name of Tri-Cities Airport Commission, its successors and assigns, including any future airport authority comprising all or any of the above referenced Property Owners in the operation of the Tri-Cities Regional Airport;

NOW, THEREFORE, intending to be legally bound, the Municipalities and Property Owners agree as follows:

1. The above referenced recitals are incorporated into this contract by reference as if fully set forth verbatim.

2. The Municipalities agree not to annex any property titled to the Property Owners, their successors or assigns, including any regional airport authority comprising all or any of the Property Owners, without the prior consent of all of the governing bodies of the Property Owners.

3. This contract applies to all of the real property presently owned and titled to the Property Owners and all property subsequently acquired by and titled to the Property Owners, their successors and assigns, that is used in conjunction with the

operations of the Tri-Cities Regional Airport, whether those operations are conducted through the Tri-Cities Airport Commission or its successors and assigns, including any future airport authority.

4. This contract shall be governed by the laws of the State of Tennessee.

5. This contract may be enforced jointly or severally by the governing body of any Municipality or Municipalities, its successors and assigns, executing this contract as a Property Owner, or executing this contract as a Municipality with the power to annex, or as an individual member of a successor entity, be it an airport authority or otherwise. This contract is binding upon each and every party to this contract, jointly and severally, and upon their successors and assigns.

This Office received a letter from Sullivan County (the "County") on June 22, 2012, requesting approval to issue tax and revenue anticipation notes ("TRANs") for the fiscal year 2013 for the General Fund, the General Purpose School Fund, the School Capital Projects (Renovation) Fund, and the General Debt Service Fund. On July 2, 2012, an email containing the required statements of cash flow analysis needed for the approval was received.

The County received approval in a letter dated May 25, 2012, of a continuing budget resolution to operate on the fiscal year 2012 budget until the fiscal year 2013 budget is passed.

The County presented financial information with the requests that represent the County's assertions of its financial condition and may or may not reflect the current or future financial condition of the County. Counties in Tennessee are authorized to issue TRANs pursuant to Tennessee Code Annotated (TCA) Title 9, Chapter 21 to provide monies for operating expenses until sufficient revenues are received. The par amount of TRANs must not exceed 60% of the annual appropriation for the fund involved, and future revenues projected must be sufficient to provide for the payment of the TRANs by June 30, 2013. Issuing these TRANs reduces the amount that the County may borrow in the future for fiscal year 2013.

Tax and Revenue Anticipation Notes

This letter constitutes approval to issue:

- \$2,144,471 General Fund TRANs, Series 2013,
- \$1,856,814 General Purpose School Fund TRANs, Series 2013,
- \$19,551 School Capital Projects (Renovation) Fund TRANs, Series 2013, and
- \$465,867 General Debt Service TRANs, Series 2013.

The issuance of the TRANs is conditional upon agreement with the following terms by the County Board of Commissioners:

• A copy of this letter shall be provided to all the members of the County Commission, be presented at the next meeting of the Commission, and be entered the minutes of the meeting.

- The County shall comply with the requirements of TCA Title 9, Chapter 21 and shall provide this Office verifiable documentation of compliance for fiscal year 2013.
- The County shall use the Tax and Revenue Anticipation Note Form enclosed with this letter.
- The County shall report the execution of the TRANs and the amounts to this Office within 45 days of issuance on Form CT-0253. A copy of the executed Tax and Revenue Anticipation Note Form used for the loan and the minutes where this letter was presented will be included with the CT-0253.
- The County shall adopt a budget Resolution and tax levy Resolution in a timely manner to permit sufficient time for the County to take any actions required to receive official budget approval from this Office.
- The County shall adopt and maintain a balanced budget with no cash deficits and be sufficient to pay operating and debt service costs.
- The County shall submit the adopted budget Resolution and tax levy Resolution and all required supporting documentation to this Office within 15 days of adoption for official budget approval.
- The County shall repay the TRANs no later than June 30, 2013 and provide this Office documentation within 15 days of the repayment, but not later than June 30, 2013. The County shall report non-issuance of the TRANs to this Office not later than June 30, 2013.

This letter and the approval to issue debt do not address compliance with federal tax regulations and should not be relied upon for that purpose. The County should discuss these issues with a tax attorney or bond counsel.

Report on Debt Obligation

Enclosed is a revised Form CT-0253 - Report on Debt Obligation. The Form CT-0253 must be filed with the governing body of the public entity issuing the debt not later than forty-five (45) days following the issuance or execution of a debt obligation by or on behalf of any public entity, with a copy (including attachments, if any) filed with the Director of the Office of State and Local Finance by email to the address below or by mail to the address on the letter. No public entity may enter into additional debt if it has failed to file the Report on Debt Obligation.
