WHEREAS, the budget documents have been submitted for approval to set the Tax Levy in Sullivan County for the 2004-2005 fiscal year, beginning July 1, 2004;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners approve the combined property tax rate for Sullivan County, Tennessee, for the Fiscal Year 2004-2005, beginning July 1, 2004; that said tax rate shall be \$2.72 on each \$100.00 of taxable property; and that said tax is to provide revenue for each of the following funds and otherwise conform to the following levies:**
