THAT WHEREAS, Enhanced 911 service has the purpose of reducing the destruction of property and preventing the loss of life, and;

WHEREAS, Enhanced 911 provides one emergency number (911) as a simplified method of reaching any emergency service in Sullivan County, including the Cities of Kingsport, Bristol, and Bluff City;

WHEREAS, the voters of Sullivan County, by referendum, created an emergency communication district for the purpose of operation an Enhanced 911 service in August of 1986;

WHEREAS, THE Tennessee Legislature has provided a method for funding the Enhanced 911 service;

WHEREAS, to improve the efficiency of the 911 service streets with multiple names must be assigned one name;

WHEREAS, streets with duplicated names must be assigned new names.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Sullivan County Board of Commissioners as follows: It being found to be in the public interest in support of the 911 service that the policy for the elimination of duplicating names and streets with multiple names shall be as follows:

1. Duplicating or multiple names within one of the three divisions of the 911 service area will be eliminated by the oldest street to retain its original name.
 2. Streets that require a name change, where possible, will be assigned suffixes or prefixes by staff assigned by the respective jurisdiction to work with the 911 Board of Directors, requiring no action by the County Commission.
- Street names that must be changed completely will be assigned new names by the County Commission.

WHEREAS, TENNESSEE CODE ANNOTATED; SECTION _____, AUTHORIZES COUNTIES _____

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Sullivan County, Tennessee, assembled in _____ Called _____ Session on the 28th day of May, 19 87,

THAT _____ WHEREAS, Public Chapter Number 508 Acts of 1981, permits a political subdivision to assume the employee's contributions; and

WHEREAS, effective July 1, 1987, the Sullivan County Board of Commissioners of Sullivan County elects to assume and make its employee's contributions to the retirement system of up to five percent (5%) of the employee's earnable compensation on behalf of all its employees in all departments; and

WHEREAS, the employee contributions paid by the employer shall be credited to the member's account provided the employee is a member of the Tennessee Consolidated Retirement System _____ a employed by the participating political subdivision on the effective date specified _____ a ve and that these contributions made on behalf of the member will be refunded to the member together with any contributions made by the member in the event the member terminates employment and makes application for a refund of contributions; and

WHEREAS, the political subdivision has the option to waive the established temporary period of employment for all employees who have not completed such period prior of July 1, 1987. The employee shall immediately become a member of the retirement system and be eligible for a refund of the employer assumed employee contributions upon termination of employment, and the employee's election not to receive a retirement allowance if such allowance is due; and

WHEREAS, should the employer elect to retain the established temporary period of employment for all employees who have not completed such period prior to July 1, 1987; such employee will be ineligible for a refund of the employer assumed employee contributions to the retirement system _____ c the effective date of the Resolution. With full knowledge and understanding of the _____ f .going provision, Sullivan County elects to (Waive/Retain) the temporary period of employment for those employees affected by this Resolution; and

WHEREAS, for the purpose of computing the average final compensation for any member retiring from a participating political subdivision electing the provisions of the Public Chapter specified above, the annual salary for all years beginning with the effective date of the passage of this Resolution to the date of retirement or until July 1, 1991, whichever occurs first, will be increased by three and six tenths of one percent (3.6%);

WHEREAS, all liabilities resulting from this Resolution shall be the responsibility of the political subdivision and not the State of Tennessee;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT, the Sullivan County Board of Commissioners of Sullivan County hereby authorizes to assume the employee's contributions of up to five percent (5%) of their earnable compensation pursuant to Public Chapter 508 Acts of 1981.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING EMERGENCY PLANNING COUNCIL

WHEREAS, TENNESSEE CODE ANNOTATED; SECTION _____, AUTHORIZES COUNTIES TO _____

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Sullivan County, Tennessee, assembled in REGULAR ADJOURNED Session on the 29th day of June, 1987,

THAT the Title III of the Superfund Amendment and Reauthorization Act (SARA) of 1986 was signed into law by President REagan on October 17, 1986, and has two basic objectives:

- 1) to prepare communities for potential chemical emergencies involving release from chemical plants and other facilities; and 2) to increase the public's knowledge on the presence of chemicals in their communities, and

WHEREAS, Section 301 (c) of the Act calls for the formation of "local emergency planning committees; to serve as the focal point for local preparedness efforts relating to hazardous materials. The committees will be comprised of State and Local elected officials, industry, emergency response personnel and other groups as specified in Section 301(c). The principal purpose of the committee is to prepare an emergency response plan to ensure the safety of the citizens of the county in the unlikely event there is a chemical release or spill, and

WHEREAS, Sullivan County has a responsibility to protect its citizens and to mitigate the efforts of natural and technological disasters affecting the citizens of this county, and

WHEREAS Title III of the Superfund Amendment and Reauthorization Act of 1986, hereinafter called the Act, mandates the establishment of an Emergency Planning Council for each county.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT, Keith Westmoreland, County Executive of Sullivan County, Tennessee, reconfirm the established Sullivan County Planning Council comprised of persons from government, business and industry having the technical, planning and management expertise to develop a county wide emergency response plan as it relates to hazardous materials emergency as outlines in the ACT.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT, Gary Mayes be appointed to serve as the facilitator to coordinate such Council and to draft a Hazardous Materials Incident Response Plan and submit to the County Executive's office no later than October, 1988.

This directive to remain in effect until rescinded by the Sullivan County Board of Commissioners or by action of law.
