

The annexations also decrease the number of employees and equipment needed in the Sheriff's Department and in the road department. Another factor in the decreasing activity of the road department is the stricter requirement for street construction in subdivisions which entail less maintenance.
5. Sullivan County's history of funding its services departments shows by its tax rate that it has been extremely generous, a fact which now contributes to this County being penalized by the State's maintenance of funds laws.
