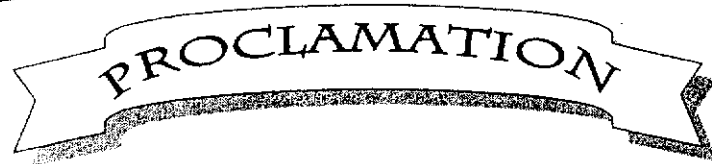

Whereas, Fay Long Buckles became a member of Central Christian Church in Bristol and remains a part of that congregation even today; and


Whereas, Fay Long married Ernest Gray Buckles, who was a Sullivan County native. When he passed away in 1996, they had been married for over 50 years; and


RE: Authorization for Tri-Cities Airport Commission to Approve or Disapprove Settlement Offers in Grande Harbor Condemnation Proceedings
