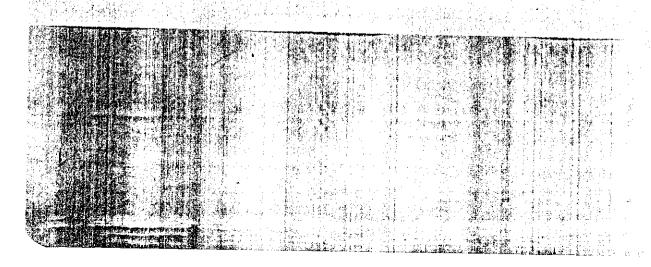
REZONING REQUESTS

MARCH 20,1989

- Consider a request Loy K. Faulk by to rezone a tract of land on the south side of Franklin Street from R-1 (Residential) to 8-2 (Business) and B-3 (Business). Motion By: Comm. Russin TO APPROVE - Second By: Comm. Ammons 2/3 Voice Vote
 Lov K. Faulk Request. Mr. Faulk, who owns 1/89-3. property on Franklin Street located in Blountville, requested that a parcel of property which he owns be rezoned from R-1 (Low Density) Residential to B-3 (General) Business. Mr. Faulk stated that two adjoining property owners were also present and that they would like for him to have only a portion of the property rezoned for B-3 and another portion of it rezoned for B-2. The eastern portion of it for B-3 and the western portion for B-2. Following a brief discussion with the property owners and Mr. Faulk, a motion was made by Mr. Barger, seconded by Mr. Russin, to approve the request as agreed upon by the property owners and requested staff to redraw the map to present to the county commission. Motion carried.
- Consider a request by Louis Gray to rezone a tract of land at the intersection of Fall Creek Road and State route 126 from R-1 (Residential) to A-1 (Agricultural). Motion by: Comm. Blalock Passed

 TO APPROVE _ Second by: Comm. Groseclose 2/3 Voice File No. 1/89-4, Louise Gray Request. Mrs. Louise Gray, who owns property on both sides of Fall Creek Road at its intersection with Highway 126, requested that her property be rezoned from R-1 (Low Density) Residential to A-1 (General) Agriculture. Mrs. Gray stated that her property was in a greenbelt classification and would like to have her property in an A-1 zone. Although no one appeared in opposition to the rezoning, the planning commission pointed out that there were several subdivisions in the general area of this request and that it was prime land to be subdivided. Therefore, Mr. Nichols made a motion, seconded by Mr. Neil to deny the request. The motion carried.
- 3. Consider a request by Billy Joe Nuckles to rezone a tract of land on the east side of Kincaid Street from R-1 (Residential) to R-2 (Residential). Motion by: Comm. Ammons Passed

 TO APPROVE Second By: Comm. Morrell 2/3 Voice Vote
 File No. 1/89-5, Billy Joe Nuckles Request. Mr. Nuckles requested that property be owns on Kincaid Street be rezoned from R-1 (Low Density) Residential to R-2 (Medium Density) Residential to permit the location of a mobile home. Mr. George Lee, an adjoining property owner, appeared and stated that he did not oppose the rezoning as long as it was not used as a mobile home park and provided that the mobile home would be used for a family member. Mr. Nuckles stated that he wanted the rezoning in order for his



son to move into the mobile home. Mr. Russin made a motion, seconded by Mr. Barger, to approve the rezoning. The motion carried, with Mrs. Pond voting no.

- Consider a request by Walter Tomlinson to rezone a tract of land 4. on the north side of Spurgeon Lane from R-1 (Residential) to A-1 (Agricultural). Motion by: Comm.Dingus Second by: Comm. Ammons TO APPROVE Second by: Comm. Ammons 2/3 Voice Vote File No. 1/89-6, Walter Tomlinson Request. Mr. Tomlinson requested that a parcel of property that he owns in the Indian Springs Community between Cochise Trail and Spurgeon Lane be rezoned from R-1 (Low Density) Residential to A-1 (General) Agriculture in order to permit the location of a mobile home for his son. Mr. Tomlinson owns a 29 acre tract of land between the two streets. Mrs. Sherill Campbell appeared before the planning commission in opposition to rezoning of the total 29 acres of land because she feared that it could be used for a mobile home park; however, she stated that she would not oppose rezoning of one acre to be used for a mobile home for Mike Cross. Mr. Tomlinson and Mr. Cross agreed that they would be willing to have only one acre of the property rezoned. Mr. Russin made a motion, seconded by Mr. Nichols to rezone the one acre for Mr. Cross provided that he brought a map to staff showing the exact location of the one acre being requested. Motion carried.
- 5. Consider a request by James and Steve Feathers to rezone a tract of land at the intersection of Weaver Pike and Harrington Hollow APPROVE. Road from R-1 (Residential) to A-2 (Agricultural).

 Motion by: Comm. Anderson, Second by: Comm. Dingus
 File No. 1/89-7 James and Steve Feathers Regulation.

 Mr. Feathers

Motion by: Comm. Anderson, Second by: Comm. Dingus 2/3 Voice Vote File No. 1/89-7, James and Steve Feathers Request. Mr. Feathers requested that a parcel of property which he cwns on Weaver Pike across from East High School be rezoned from R-1 (Low Density) Residential to A-1 (General) Agriculture. Mr. Feathers stated that he wanted the property rezoned because it was his understanding that he could not locate a barn or any other agriculture enterprise on the property because it was zoned for Rl (Residential). The planning commission advised Mr. Feathers that the zoning ordinance specifically excluded agriculture buildings and agriculture lands from the requirements of the zoning ordinance and asked Mr. Feathers if he would be interested in having it rezoned A-2 (Agriculture) instead of A-1 (General) Agriculture. Mr. James Feathers stated that he was representing his father and he did not know how he would feel if the property were rezoned for A-2 rather than A-1. Mr. Nichols made a motion, seconded by Mr. Russin that the property be rezoned from R-1 to A-2 Agriculture. Motion carried.

6. Consider a request by H. Ralph Blizzard to rezone a tract of land at the intersection of State Route 37 and Red Bud Lane from A-2 (Agricultural) to M-1 (Manufacturing).

Motion by: Comm. Groseclose, Second by: Comm. Russin 2/3 Voice Vote File No. 1/89-8, H. Ralph Blizard Request. A request was made by Mr. Ralph Blizard to rezone a parcel of property located at the intersection of Highway 87 and I-81 from A-2 (Agriculture-Residential) to M-1 (Manufacturing). Mr. Mark Blizard, Chairman of the planning commission, stated that he was representing his grandmother on this request and stepped down as Chairman from the planning commission turning it over to Mr. Kammie Nichols, Vice Chairman. Mr. Blizard stated that he would like to have the property rezoned to M-1 (Manufacturing) in light of the action taken by the planning commission at the last meeting which rezoned the property directly across the street from this property to an M-1 zone. Staff stated that its location adjacent to Highway 37 and I-81 made it attractive for manufacturing use, and recommended that the request be approved. Mr. Russin made a motion, seconded by Mr. Neil to approve the request. Motion carried.
