



## To Declare May As ALS Awareness Month

WHEREAS, Amyotrophic Lateral Sclerosis (ALS), known by many as Lou Gehrig's disease, is a progressive neurodegenerative disease that attacks nerve cells and pathways in the brain and spinal cord. When these cells die, voluntary muscle control and movement dies with them. Patients in the later stages of the disease are totally paralyzed, yet in most cases, their minds remain sharp and alert.

WHEREAS, Every day, an average of 15 people are newly diagnosed with ALS - more than 5,600 people per year and as many as 30,000 Americans may currently be affected by ALS. Annually, ALS is responsible for two deaths per 100,000 people.

WHEREAS, the average life expectancy of a person with ALS is two to five years from time of diagnosis; however, with recent advances in research and improved medical care, many patients are living longer, more productive lives. Half of all those affected live at least three years or more after diagnosis. About 20 percent live five years or more, and up to ten percent will survive more than ten years.

WHEREAS, ALS occurs throughout the world with no racial, ethnic, or socioeconomic boundaries. ALS can strike anyone. Every single American is threatened by this disease.

WHEREAS, The ALS Association has committed more than 567 million to find effective treatments and a cure for Lou Gehrig's Disease. Their global research effort has helped increase the number of scientists working on ALS, advanced new discoveries and treatments, and has shed light on the complex genetic and environmental factors involved in ALS.

WHEREAS, raising public awareness of this disease will lead to increased support for Tennessee families living with ALS and facilitate the discovery of a cure.

NOW THEREFORE, I, Richard S. Venable, Mayor of Sullivan County
do hereby recognize

Honorable Commissioner,

On January 13, 2016, Austin Ramsey and Griffin Winkle approached the Sullivan County Local Emergency Planning Committee to discuss a potential 4-H project that might benefit emergency preparedness in Sullivan County. The idea that resulted was to update the county's casualty collection points. Many years ago, casualty collection points were developed to bring seriously injured victims to specific areas throughout the county. Working with the LEPC and EMA, these gentlemen took the old date points and using GIS data, pinpointed these locations more accurately and placed them on a map.

Sullivan County EMA was able to visit these locations through the GIS maps and decide each locations capability and need. Some of the older points had been built over though growth. These new points were classified by capability. These points were classified into three categories such as capability to receive a large truck, helicopter or whether there was a structure close by to be out of the weather.

These new points will be used in case of different emergencies. They can still be used to receive multiple sick or injured victims but also a place to distribute emergency supplies such as water, blankets or food during a major disaster.

By placing all this information on the GIS maps and making it available electronically, local emergency planners were able to "visit" these locations form computer and not have to physically drive to each location saving many hours and fuel usage. These young men also took it a step further and able to show the fewest number of points to reach the largest percentage of the population in case of wide spread damage during a major disaster.

Sullivan County LEPC is extremely grateful for the work these young men completed and would like to recognize them during the May County Commission Meeting and also give them a plaque of our appreciation. WE would also like to congratulate them on getting a 2<sup>nd</sup> place award in the 2016 Tennessee 4 – H GIS contest and be invited to the national contest in California this summer.
