





THAT BE IT RESOLVED. That in the interest of being properly consistent, the Sullivar County Private Acts relating to duties of the County Attorney be amended as follows and that these amendments be forwarded by the County Attorney to the County's State Representatives and Senator for action in the 1994 General Assembly:
Under "ARTICLE IV. THE COUNTY ATTORNEY"
In Section 1-1-93, page 15, delete paragraph 1 in its entirety and substitute the following
[The] County Attorney shall be the attorney and solicitor for the County in all legal matters, in which the County requires the services of an attorney or solicitor, including all suits in which the County has an interest now pending in any of the courts, either by the County or against the County and all suits hereafter brought either by the County or against the County and all suits hereafter brought either by the County or against the County and all suits hereafter brought either by the County or against the County and all suits hereafter brought either by the County or against the County and all suits hereafter brought either by the County or against the County or against the County or against the County and all suits hereafter brought either by the County or against the County of the

against it. He shall represent the County in all condemnation cases, all civil suits brought against the County except when the County Commission votes to contract otherwise, and absent a conflict of interest, in all suits involving county officials in their official duties, review all contracts to be entered into by the County, review all resolutions prior to vote to determine legality, file and prosecute all tax delinquency matters, unless otherwise assigned to the Delinquent Tax Attorney for prosecution after appointment by the County trustee with approval of the County Executive. [The] Delinquent Tax Attorney's compensation shall be negotiated by the County Trustee in accordance with State statutory procedure and orders of the Chancery Court regulating delinquent tax collection procedure. [He shall also] attend all meetings of the County Court, both regular and called session, attend all committee meetings when requested by the chairman to do so. attend the meetings of the school board when requested to do so by the chairman, prosecute all cases involving the personal use of County funds by any County official including use of assets of the County for personal use, advise the county judge and members of the County Court upon request on legal matters concerning County government, advise all County officeholders upon request concerning legal matters, and do all other things required by statute and the act creating the office of County Attorney. The County Attorney shall be allowed to maintain his private law practice provided it does not interfere with, or come into conflict with, his official duties as county attorney.

In Section 1-1-96, page 16, delete the caption in its entirety and substitute the following:

A RESOLUTION

to authorize certain Group 1 members to cover certain service rendered by such members under the provisions applicable to Group 2 members of the Tennessee Consolidated Retirement System in accordance with Public Chapter Number 543, Acts of 1992.

WHEREAS, Public Chapter Number 542, Acts of 1992 authorizes a political subdivision participating in the Tennessee Consolidated Retirement System (Retirement System) to permit any Group 1 member of the Retirement System employed with such political subdivision as a sheriff on April 30, 1992 to cover service rendered by such member as a policeman, sheriff, or deputy sheriff under the retirement eligibility, benefit and contribution provisions applicable to Group 2 members of the Retirement System provided such member has creditable service in the Retirement System based upon service as a state policeman, wildlife officer, policeman, sheriff, or deputy sheriff prior to July 1, 1976;

WHEREAS, Public Chapter Number 542, Acts of 1992 sets forth three (3) conditions which must be met prior to allowing such members to make the above election. Said conditions are as follows:

(1) The political subdivision authorizes and pays for the cost of an actuarial study to determine the liability associated with the granting of such benefits;

- (2) Following the review of the cost of granting such benefits, the chief governing body of the political subdivision passes a resolution authorizing the benefits for such members, and accepting liability therefor; and
- (3) Any such member making the above election pays to the retirement system in a lump sum the difference between what he would have contributed had such service been covered under the Group 2 provisions and the amount he actually paid, plus interest at the rate provided in Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 8-37-214; and

WHEREAS, an actuarial study has been conducted to determine the liability associated with the granting of such benefits.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that having reviewed the cost of granting such benefits, the Board of Commissioners of Sullivan County, (Name of Governing Body) (Name of Political Subdivision)

Tennessee hereby authorizes any member meeting the requirements of Public Chapter Number 542, Acts of 1992 to elect coverage under the provisions of said Chapter and accepts the liability therefor.
