AMENDMENT TO PROPOSED ZONING RESOLUTION

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that if the Proposed Zoning Resolution is passed that it shall

contain for a clear understanding of its impact the following section:

1) The passage of this resolution does not in and of itself change the zoning

classification on any parcel of land from its present classification without hearings on

that parcel of land before the Sullivan County Planning Commission and the Sullivan

County Commission with a majority vote for the change before the Sullivan County

Commission;

2) As is now required, a notice of any proposed change shall be by newspaper, sign

posting, and a letter to the owner of the parcel on which the change is sought and all

adjacent property owners;

-3) If the County or the owner, seeks the change of classification of any parcel, the notice

process shall be began at least 60 days prior to the hearing before the Planning

Commission;

4) The purpose of this section is to protect and ensure the existing zoning classification

rights of both the owner of the parcel and the existing rights of adjacent property

owners and to provide for due process on any proposed change.
