Being a tract of land lying in the 9th Civil District between Austin Springs Road and U. S. Highway 11-E approximately 600 feet south of its intersection with Edgefield Road and further described as that part of parcel 32 map 140 of the Sullivan County Tax Maps lying north of a line parallel to Austin Springs Road at a distance of 500 feet.

The Planning Commission took the following action:

File No. 7/92-9 Sandra Merkel Request. Consider a request to rezone a tract of land located in the 9th civil district between Austin Springs Road and U. S. Highway 11-E approximately 600 feet south of its intersection with Edgefield Road from R-1 to B-3 to permit the location of future business development.

Mr. Willis was present representing the applicant and spoke in support of the request. Paul Kelley and Jerry Dayls property owners in the area spoke in opposition to the request citing potential surface water drainage problems.

Staff noted that a multiple zoning for the properties would be compatible with surrounding land uses and would address potential drainage problems, staff suggested that the southerly half of the property fronting on Austin Springs Road be zoned R-1, low density residential and that the northerly half of the property fronting on U. S. Highway 11E be zoned PBD; planned business district, the division between the two proposed zones being delineated by a line following the approximate crest of the hill on the property, the line further described as running parallel to Austin Springs Road at a distance of 500 feet. The applicant accepted this suggestion.

Motion by Eldreth, second by Green to approve zoning as recommended by staff; voting in favor of the motion: Eldreth, Green, Hickam, Koehner, Teague; vote opposed to the motion: Belcher; Abstaining: Brown, the motion carried.

TO APPROVE REQUEST APPROVED 10/19/92 Roll Call Being a tract of land lying in the 11th Civil District on the south side of Bloomingdale Pike on the west side of its intersection with Sunny Lane and further described as parcel 10.10 group C map 31-H of the Sullivan County Tax Maps.

The Planning Commission took the following action:

File No. 6/92-3, Jimmy Anderson Request. Consider a request to rezone a tract of land located in the 11th civil district on the south side of Bloomingdale Pike on the west side of its Intersection with Sunny Lane from R-1 to B-3 to permit the location of a retail business. The applicant was present and spoke in support of the request. Carl Moles, resident of the area was present and spoke in opposition to the request citing potential decrease in his residential property values.

Staff noted that the commission had previously denied this same request over 1 year ago. That conditions had not changed and that the proposed zoning would be incompatible with property development in the immediate area. Staff recommended the request be deried.

File # 7/92-7 A request by Lemar Ltd. to rezone the property described below from R-1 to PRD: Motion approved 10/19/92 Roll Call TO APPROVE PLANNING COMMISSIONS RECOMMENDATION TO DENY Being a tract of fand lying in the 5th Civil Districts on the south side of State Route 37 east of its Intersection with Buncombe Road and further described as parcels 14, 15 and 16 group B map 66-K of the Sullivan County Tax Maps.

The Planning Commission took the following action:

File No. 7/92-6, Albert Moretz Request. Consider a request to rezone a tract of land located in the 5th civil district on both sides of State Route 37 east of its intersection with Buncombe Road from R-1 to PRD to permit the location of apartments or condominiums, File No. 7/92-7, Lemar Ltd. Request. Consider a request to rezone a tract of land located on the 4th and 5th civil districts on the south side of State Route 37 east of its intersection with Buncombe Road from R-1 to PRD to permit the location of apartments or condominiums, and File No. 8/92-1, R. C. Houser Request. Consider a request to rezone a tract of land located in the 5th civil district on the south side of Buncombe Road approximately 2000 feet west of its intersection with State Route 37 from R-1 to PRD to permit the location of apartments or condominiums.

Staff noted that requests 7/92-6, 7/92-7 and 8/92-1 were

adjacent properties with similar requests and should be considered simultaneously due to the interrelatedness of their combined potential impact on the area. Staff Informed the commission that a tast minute request by applicant 7/92-7 had deleted the entire property for rezoning except for lots 14,15 and 18 containing a total of 1.38 acres fronting on south side of SR 37 approximately 2000 feet east of Buncombe Road, and a request by applicant 8/92-1 had deleted that property in its entirety for the rezoning. The rezonings remaining to be considered by the commission are request 7/92-6 in its entirety and request 7/92-7 composed of lots 14, 15 and 18 on SR 37. Staff displayed maps of the area encompassing the applications 7/92-6 and 7/92-7 and 8/92-1 and distributed a staff analysis of the proposed PRD rezoning of the Tri City Golf Course area (including applications 7/92-6, 7/92-7 and 8/92-1). A copy of the analysis dated August 18, 1992 is attached and hereby made a part of these minutes. Based on this analysis staff recommended (1) that an 8.09 acre portion of application 7/92-6 lying on the southerly side of SR 37 be denied zoning to PRD and that the remaining 11.51 acre portion of application 7/92-8 lying on the northerly side of SR 37 be approved for rezoning to PRD and (2) that the 1.38 acre portion of application 7/92-7 encompassing lots 14, 15 and 16 fronting on the southerly side of SR 37 approximately 2000 feet east of Buncombe Road be approved for rezoning to PRD noting that the lots ile adjacent to an existing PRD zone and can be served by existing sanitary sewer lines.

Applicants for requests 7/92-6 and 7/92-7 were present and spoke on behalf of their proposals. Paul Damell also spoke in support of the applications: Ron Ramsey, area resident was present and spoke of his concerns about proposed development. Robin Skien, Jim Akins, Verlin Hale, Brenda Bays, Mark Worley and other residents of the Tri City Gotf Course area were present and spoke in opposition to the requests citing negative impacts of the proposed rezoning including, surface water drainage problems and potential flooding along Evans Creek and its watershed area, decreased property values, inadequate water and sewer service, dangerous traffic conditions and incompatibility of the proposals with existing residential land use and zoning patterns in place prior to and at the outset of the Zoning resolution in 1988. Residents in opposition also presented a signed petition with approximately 66 signatures of other residents in the gotf course area opposed to the rezoning request.

The commission considered all statements. Motion by Eldreth, second by Belcher to deny rezoning request 7/92-6 and 7/92-7 as amended due to unresolved drainage and potential flood problems, inadequate infrastructure to serve the potential development, dangerous traffic conditions and incompatibility with existing residential development; vote in favor of the motion: Eldreth, Belcher, Teague, Green, Hickam; vote opposed to the motion: Brown; abstaining: Koehner; the motion carried, rezoning request 7/92-6 and rezoning request 7/92-7 as amended are denied.

Staff recommended request 8/92-2 be denied citing its incompatibility of the existing land use and established zoning patterns in the rural residential area.
