The Planning Commission took the following action:

Consider a request to rezone a tract of land located in the 10th civil district on the west side of Crystal View Street approximately 350 feet north of its intersection with Bentley Street from R-1 and R-3A to R-2 to permit the location of a single wide mobile home.

Miss Betty Wyatt was present representing the applicant and spoke in favor of the request. Mr. Mike Loveless and other adjacent property owners were present and spoke in opposition to the request citing unsafe roadway conditions due to steep and narrow road and possible negative influence on property values of the existing homes and inadequate utilities specifically water pressure. Mr. Loveless also presented a petition in opposition to the request with 25 signatures of adjacent homeowners. Staff noted that the well established low density residential neighborhood was shielded by the only other mobile homes in the area by topography and existing trees on the downhill side of the street and that the neighborhood on top of the hill was totally single family residential in nature. Staff noted that the proposed use would be incompatible with the R-1 low density neighborhood and would be intrusive in nature and recommended that the request be denied.

AMEND ARTICLE VI PLANNED DEVELOPMENT DISTRICTS OF THE SULLIVAN COUNTY ZONING RESOLUTION BY THE DELETION OF EXISTING SECTION 615.4.3 AND THE SUBSTITUTION OF NEW SECTION 615.4.3 TO READ AS FOLLOWS: "615.4.3 Planned business district -3 (PBD-3). Any use permitted in the B-3 Business District."

Section IV. AMEND ARTICLE VI PLANNED DEVELOPMENT DISTRICTS OF THE SULLIVAN COUNTY ZONING RESOLUTION BY THE ADDITION OF NEW SECTION 615.4.4 AND 615.4.5, RENUMBERING ALL SUBSEQUENT SECTIONS ACCORDINGLY TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

"615.4.4. Planned manufacturing district - 1 (PMD-1). Any use permitted in the M-1 Industrial District", and "615.4.5. Planned manufacturing district - 2 (PMD-2). Any use permitted in any industrial district except automobile wrecking, salvage and junkyards; hazardous and non-hazardous waste disposal."

Section V. Any place within the Sullivan County Zoning Resolution where the term "PMD-Planned Manufacturing District" appears, it shall be stricken and replaced with the term "PMD-2 Planned Manufacturing District -2", and the official zoning map of Sullivan County shall also reflect this change.

Motion Holler, second Trivett to amend the zoning resolution as follows: create a Planned Business District -3 (PBD-3) with permitted uses to include only those uses allowed in the B-3 district. Vote in favor of the motion: unanimous.

Motion Trivett, second Belcher to amend the zoning resolution as follows: Delete the planned manufacturing district (PMD) and create a Planned Manufacturing District -1 (PMD-1) with permitted uses to include only those uses allowed in the M-1 industrial district; and create a Planned Manufacturing District -2 (PMD-2) with permitted uses to include any use permitted in any industrial district except automobile wrecking, salvage and junkyards; hazardous and non-hazardous waste disposal. Vote in favor of the motion: unanimous.

SPECIAL FUNDING REQUEST

REQUEST:

We are requesting an additional appropriation from Sullivan County for fiscal year 1993-1994 in the amount of \$40,000.00.

PROBLEM:

We have two vehicles that are in deteriorating condition due to age and usage. We are currently not able to take on additional indebtedness because of limitations on our ability to produce income. Currently, we are obligated to truck payments in the amount of \$28,828.41 per year. The Enigne 4 payment is \$14,007.69 per year and continues for three more years and the Truck 2 payment is \$11,832.60 per year (\$986.05 per month) for the next four and one-half years.

SOLUTION:

The payoff for Truck 2 (as of July 16th) is \$42,170.00. If we have funds to pay off this loan, we will then have the ability to make payments needed to replace or refurbish our aging fire equipment. As an additional benefit, payoff of this loan now will save over \$10,000.00 in interest payments over the rest of the term of the loan.

POTENTIAL CONSEQUENCES:

If we are forced to wait until we can pay off one of our two current loans without special funding, our vehicles will further deteriorate, resulting in longer periods of maintenance downtime. Even a small repair costing only a few dollars can sometimes result in several days of out-of-service time. When equipment is out of service, our ability to provide needed services to the approximately six thousand homes and 200+ businesses in our service area is severely impaired. Having to wait for a tanker or pumper from a neighboring department can mean the difference between only minor damage or losing an entire structure to fire.

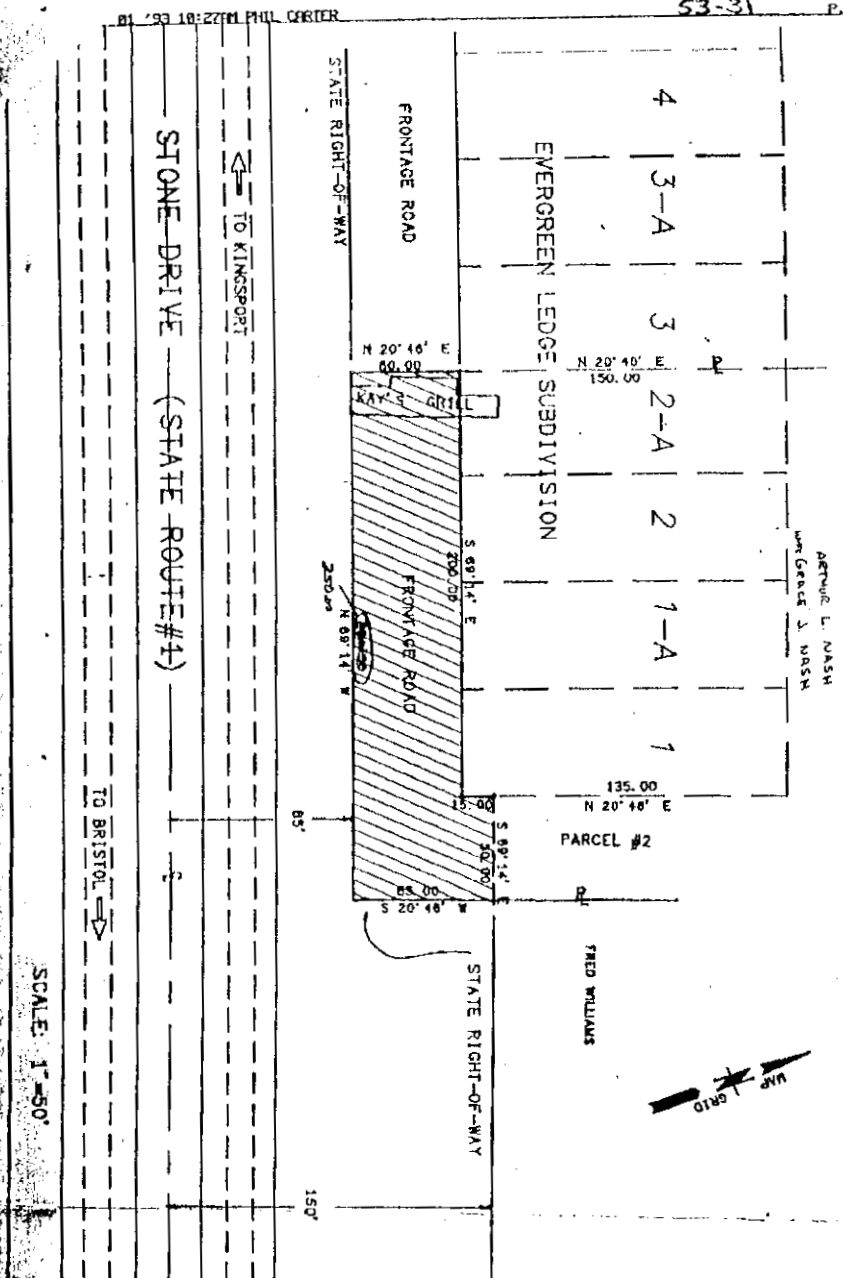
