

RESOLUTION Authorizing Application to be made for grant funds through the First Tennessee Development District for Tennessee Department of Transportation Multimodal Access Fund. The project is known as the Battle of Blountville Civil War Military Park – Phase I.

WHEREAS, the Battle of Blountville Civil War Military Park Executive Board has developed a Vision Plan for the Battle of Blountville Civil War Military Park to include three primary Points of Interest as follows: (1) the Welcome/Entrance area at State Highway 394 and Blountville By-Pass; (2) the historic Blountville Cemetery where Union troops were positioned during the Civil War; and (3) the grounds at the present-day Blountville Middle School where Confederate troops were positioned during the Civil War;

WHEREAS, the project will provide the basic pedestrian infrastructure including sidewalks, signage, pedestrian refuge islands and crosswalks to connect the three primary Points of Interest for the Battle of Blountville Civil War Military Park as designated by the Battle of Blountville Civil War Military Park Executive Board;

WHEREAS, the Tennessee Department of Transportation Multimodal Access Grant funds can be used to provide the necessary funds to local governments to support the transportation needs of transit users, pedestrians and bicyclists through infrastructure projects that address existing gaps along state routes;

WHEREAS, the overall grant request is \$1,000,000 with proposed funding from the State of \$950,000 and the remaining local match of 5% not to exceed \$50,000;

WHEREAS, application and administration of grant shall be overseen by the Battle of Blountville Civil War Military Park grant committee comprised of one county commissioner, the Director of Archives and Tourism, the County Planning Director and two members of the Battle of Blountville Civil War Military Park Executive Board;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners of Sullivan County, Tennessee, assembled in Regular Session, hereby authorize the submittal of the application through the First Tennessee Development District for the Tennessee Department of Transportation Access Grant, which is due no later than November 1, 2015.

RESOLUTION TO INCREASE THE THRESHOLD OVER WHICH PUBLIC ADVERTISEMENT AND SEALED COMPETITVE BIDS OR PROPOSALS ARE REQUIRED

To the Honorable Richard S. Venable, Mayor of Sullivan County, and the Board of Sullivan County Commissioners meeting in Regular Session this 19th day of October, 2015.

WHEREAS, 2015 Public Chapter 457 has amended Title 12, Chapter 3, to authorize the Sullivan County Commission to, by resolution, increase the threshold over which public advertisement and sealed competitive bids or proposals are required to an amount not to exceed \$25,000 for non-emergency, non-proprietary purchases in counties having centralized purchasing and a full-time purchasing agent; and

WHEREAS, Sullivan County has centralized purchasing and a full-time purchasing agent; and

WHEREAS, the board of County Commissioners of Sullivan County is desirous of realizing the cost and time savings to the county's purchasing department which an increase in the formal bid threshold would bring, and believes that raising the formal bid threshold to \$15,000 would be in the best interest of Sullivan County.

NOW THERFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the board of county commissioners of Sullivan County, meeting in regular session that:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to the provisions of 2015 Public Chapter 457, the threshold over which public advertisement and sealed competitive bids or proposals are required in Sullivan County is hereby raised to Fifteen Thousand (\$15,000) for nonemergency, nonproprietary purchases.

SECTION 2. Pursuant to the provisions of 2015 Public Chapter 457, the purchasing agent is required to obtain at least three (3) written quotations, whenever possible, for purchases costing less than the bid threshold set out in Section 1 but greater than 40% of the bid threshold.

SECTION 3. This resolution shall be effective upon its passage and approval, the public welfare requiring it. The new bid threshold shall apply to all purchases initiated on or after that date.

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 6. Chapter 56 and Title 12, Chapter 3, relative to local government purchasing bid thresholds.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 12, Chapter 3, is amended by adding the following language as a new, appropriately designated section:

Notwithstanding any charter provision, private act, or other law to the contrary, any county, municipality, utility district, or other local governmental entity having centralized purchasing authority with a full-time purchasing agent is authorized, by resolution or ordinance of its governing body, to increase the threshold over which public advertisement and sealed competitive bids or proposals are required to an amount not to exceed twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) for nonemergency, nonproprietary purchases. At least three (3) written quotations shall be required whenever possible for purchases costing less than the bid threshold established for public advertisement and sealed competitive bids or proposals but more than forty percent (40%) of such bid threshold or some lower amount as may be established by the governing body in the resolution. Purchases of like items shall be aggregated for purposes of the bid threshold.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.

RESOLUTION To Authorize the Sullivan County Purchasing Agent to execute Contract Amendment # 2 with Securus Technologies Inc, an inmate communications company, for their ConnectUs Law Library Application program

WHEREAS, Securus Technologies, Inc., in accordance with Federal Communications Commission (FCC) 47 CFR Part 64, currently provides the inmate telephone system for the Sullivan County Correctional Facility at no cost to the county and generates revenue for Sullivan County at an average of approximately \$12,000-\$15,000 per month; and

WHEREAS, Contract Amendment # 1 with Securus Technologies Inc. was recently approved extending the term of our Agreement for another five (5) years; and

WHEREAS, Sullivan County Sheriff's Office, as required, provides inmates reasonable access to Federal and State legal case law and requires annual updates; and

WHEREAS, Securus will provide Video Visitation on up to 34 inmate side terminals allowing face-to-face visits between inmates and visitors, and will provide the Law Library Application on up to 34 inmate side terminals allowing inmates legal research capability; and

WHEREAS, the Securus ConnectUs Law Library Application program is a turn-key service for Jails designed to allow inmates to perform independent legal research by using a touch screen without training or computer experience with online, real time legal information availability; and

WHEREAS, the fee for providing this service is \$.05 per call, which will be added to the "per call charge" calling rates for all calls (excluding interstate) by the inmates; and

WHEREAS, the Sullivan County Sheriff's Office will be allowed to designate an "Admin" staff having full access capability to the Securus Law Library at no additional cost,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners of Sullivan County, Tennessee, assembled in Regular Session, hereby authorizes the Sullivan County Purchasing Agent to execute amendment # 2 with Securus Technologies, Inc. for their ConnectUs Law Library Application program in both Sullivan County Correctional Facilities.
