RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING <u>The County Attorney to Take Legal Action Against the</u> <u>City of Bristol, TN Regarding Its Annexation of the Undeveloped Land in Tri-County</u> Industrial Park

WHEREAS, TENNESSEE CODE ANNOTATED; SECTION _____, AUTHORIZES

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Sullivan County, Tennessee, assembled in <u>Regular</u> Session on the <u>17th</u> day of <u>October</u> 19 <u>94</u>

THAT <u>WHEREAS</u>. The City of Bristol, Tennessee, on September 29, 1994, completed its annexation of several properties in the Piney Flats community including the annexation of more than 200 acres of undeveloped land in the Tri-County Industrial Park, and

WHEREAS, The owners of the Tri-County Industrial Park are: Sullivan County - 50%; Johnson City, TN - 25%; Elizabethton, TN - 12-1/2% and Bristol, TN - 12-1/2%, and

WHEREAS, At the creation of the above Park it was never intended that it be annexed by any one-part owner because city taxes, especially Bristol's, would be a detriment to any effort to attract and secure industries for location in the Park, and

WHEREAS, The Tri-County Industrial Park is adequately served by urban utilities and local fire department and Sheriff's Department, and

WHEREAS, Since the City of Bristol cannot offer the Park any services which it does not already possess, and therefore the City of Bristol's acquisition must be solely for revenue purposes which is prohibited by Tennessee Law, now

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED. That the Sullivan County Board of Commissioners instruct the County Attorney to take legal action against the City of Bristol. TN regarding its annexation of the undeveloped land in Tri-County Industrial Park.
